Application Process

1. Apply to Hidden Acres

Application

- Complete and submit the online application

References

- Select four individuals (work, academic, spiritual, and character) to complete online reference forms

 - Provide references with the link to complete the reference form

Transcripts

- Send all undergraduate transcripts to Hidden Acres (can be unofficial transcripts)
 - Email, mail, or fax to Jesse Evans or upload with online application

Resume

- Send a current resume to Hidden Acres
 - Email, mail, or fax to Jesse Evans or upload with online application

Interview

- After Hidden Acres has received your application, four references, transcripts, and resume we will schedule an interview, either in person or via Zoom

2. Apply to a Partner University

Applicants choose between similar degree programs at one of two partner universities. Each school has its own admissions process that needs to be completed for an applicant to be considered for The Residency.

Anchor Christian University

- Submit an application online at anchoru.com/apply

- Have official undergraduate transcripts sent to Anchor Christian University, 8854 SW 11th St., Boca Raton, FL 33433.

Southwest Baptist University

- Start an application online at sbuniv.edu/admissions/apply. Make sure to select the August enrollment period for the Fall semester and the MA Organizational Leadership program.
- An SBU admissions representative will guide you through the application process, which will include requesting a reference using their online tool and having official undergraduate transcripts sent to SBU.
- Make sure to communicate to the SBU admissions rep that you are applying for the MA Organizational Leadership as part of a program managed by Eleven:6 in partnership with The Residency at Hidden Acres.
