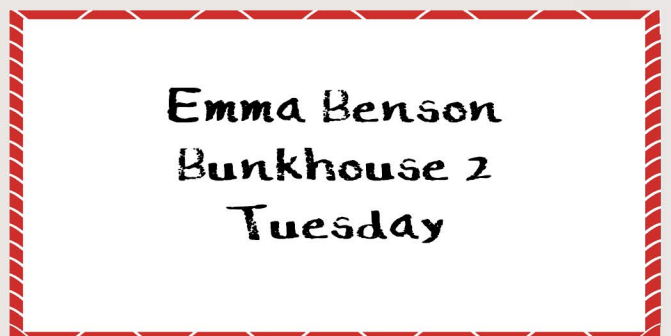


# SENDING CAMPER MAIL

## MAIL DROP OFF



One of the most convenient ways to give mail to your camper is to leave letters at our “Mail Drop Off” station on Sunday after you drop your kids off at their cabin. This mail station is set up from 3-5pm along the main road near the camp exit. Address each piece of mail with your child’s first name, last name, cabin name, and desired day of delivery, and hand them to our staff at the mail station on your way out.

Only standard letter sizes are accepted; please **do not** leave packages or large envelopes for your camper as they will **NOT** be delivered.

## POSTAL SERVICE



You’re welcome to send letters and cards through normal mail. If you choose this method, we recommend you send the letters three days before your child’s camp starts to make sure they arrive during their week. Address the envelope with the camper’s name and our mailing address: **3837 Union Ave, Dayton, IA 50530**. We receive mail late each afternoon, so your letter will be delivered the morning after it’s received. Once again, please **do not** send packages or large envelopes.

## BUNK1 EMAILS



Bunk1 is a service we partner with to allow campers to receive emails while they’re at camp. No, your kids aren’t at computers reading your messages. Bunk1 sends us a batch of emails once per day, which we then print and deliver. Campers can’t reply, but we know they love receiving news from home! Emails sent by 10pm each day will be delivered the next morning. As such, please do not send emails after 10pm on the night before your child’s camp ends.

To use Bunk1’s service, navigate to [Bunk1.com](http://Bunk1.com) and log in. If you’re new to the service and need to create an account, you’ll need to know that your invitation code is 20HIDDENACRES25. In general, emails cost about \$1.00 each to send. They also offer an online photo gallery and photo product ordering.
