Hidden Acres Christian Center is a camp and conference center purchased in 1979 by the Central District Evangelical Free Churches. Our mission is to be "a place set apart to encounter Jesus."

We are located on 660 forested acres near Dayton, lowa, in the beautiful Des Moines River Valley. Today we have more than 60 buildings, housing for over 800, and a dining hall that seats 1,000. Hidden Acres offers many enjoyable activities, including an indoor pool & hot tub, gym, game room, lake, pond, blob, sledding hill, climbing wall, zip line, giant swing, horse rides, and hiking paths. We typically host over 20,000 guests each year. Last summer, we had over 3,800 summer campers and 180 summer staff.


Students will need to complete an application, provide four references, and conduct an interview.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

PROJECT PATH is a gap year program for college-age students interested in living, learning, working, and growing at Hidden Acres. The student can choose between one of two paths to take in the program: a vocational path or an academic path. The vocational path is a work-focused path where students will primarily work at camp. The academic path gives students the opportunity to take college courses online from Emmaus University while also getting vocational experience working at camp. All students will participate in weekly Bible study and life skills classes and receive mentorship.

WORK STIPEND: \$1,200/MONTH

Students will receive a monthly stipend for their work at camp. Over a semester, their stipend will equal approximately \$4,800.

Total of program cost and tuition for one course Due in full on October 1 and February 1 Students may take up to two additional courses, for a maximum semester cost of \$4,300 for nine credits.
